

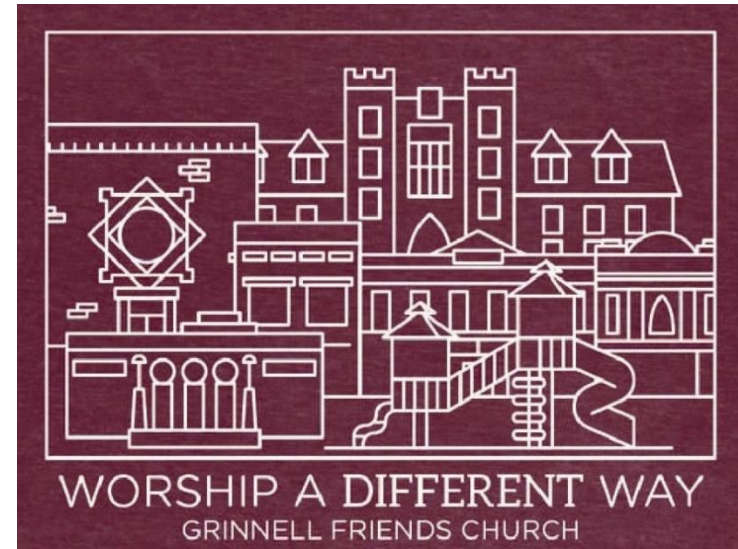
“He Is Risen Indeed!”
