

"The Power For Oneness"

FOCUS: Unless you can genuinely answer "Yes" to all three questions, you will lack the POWER to build your home with the oneness God intends.

1. Are	You and	Your Spouse	

If you DO genuinely recognize that marriage belongs to the Lord, then you also need to recognize that YOU must belong to the Lord if He is to help you have a successful marriage.

• Genesis 3:23-24

Nearly everyone knows **John 3:16**. But many never go on to read **John 3:36** (NIV): "Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him."

We don't like to think much of God's wrath anymore, but we dare not ignore it. God's wrath does NOT bring His love in question. Actually, it's just the opposite. God's wrath is a **necessary** expression of His love. GOD MUST ONE DAY FINALLY PUT AN END TO THE SINFUL REBELLION THAT HAS TAKEN OVER OUR WORLD! His love demands it

- Matthew 25:41
- 2 Peter 3:9
- Romans 6:23

Sin is the seed of Death – both physical and **spiritual** – which dominates our condition. We can never go **back** to a time before our sin, but God does call us **forward**.

- Acts 2:21
- Revelation 20:11-15

If you HAVE been born again, and are married, you may be wondering why you STILL are having so much trouble

experiencing the oneness God ordains.

Have YOU been living like a "cheese and cracker" Christian? Do you genuinely grasp that Christ WANTS you to have real oneness in your marriage? And do you understand it is part of what He bought for you on the Cross?

Don't just take a little of what Christ has for you? Don't keep him in a corner of your life and marriage. Let Jesus Christ not only be your Savior, but let Him also be your Lord!

Dr. Billy Graham has observed that most Christians today live in "self-imposed spiritual poverty." Is one of them...YOU?

That leads us to our second question...

- 2. Are You and Your Spouse Both Allowing Christ to Control Your Lives?
 - We call this FULL CONSECRATION. It is where you truly submit all of your life to God. It is an act of both Faith and Obedience. It is where one truly receives Christ as both Savior and Lord!

- 3. Are You and Your Spouse Both Allowing the Holy Spirit to ______ You?

• Ephesians 5:15-18

The Holy Spirit fills individuals AND marriages. It involves a humble submission to God and to each other. Selfishness is cast down, and Oneness takes its place - a Oneness with God, and a Oneness with each other in marriage.
