Earlier this fall there was money given to the Samburu Mission to build a facility that could house seven different stalls. The stalls would be rented for the selling of food and wares. This facility would provide seven local merchants who have done business for years a more permanent market site. The Samburu Mission used pastoral funds to help build this open sided building. However before it was completed, a bad wind-storm ripped off the roof and halted the entire project. All the money is gone now so there can be no income earned until it is finished. A good estimate of \$8,000 will complete the permanent market site. The IAYM Mission board is willing to do a \$2000 matching fund for this Easter Offering for Samburu. The reality is if we can help many people get a good start, they will flourish and have to depend on outside help less.
