- Written over a 1600 year span.
- Written over 60 generations.
- Written as 66 books by 40 plus authors, including kings, peasants, philosophers, fishermen, poets, statesmen and scholars.
- Written on three continents (Asia, Africa and Europe).
- Written in three languages: Hebrew, Aramaic and Greek.

- Written without even ONE original text still in our possession.
- Written so that "The 'Paradise Lost' of the Genesis becomes the 'Paradise Regained' of Revelation. Whereas the gate to the tree of life is closed in Genesis, it is opened forevermore in Revelation." Geisler and Nix (A GENERAL INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE, Moody Press, 1968) as found in Ibid., p. 19.
